TO: ALL CUSTOMS BROKERS

SUBJECT: CUSTOMS BROKERS USER FEE PAYMENT FOR 2008

Federal Register Notice /Vol. 72, No. 241/dated Monday, December 17, 2007 provides notice to customs brokers that the annual fee of \$138 shall be assessed for each permit held by a broker, whether it may be an individual, partnership, association, or corporation. In accordance with the afore-mentioned notice, this Broker User Fee is due by February 15, 2008.

Customs and Border Protection regulations 19 CFR 24.22(h) and (i)(9) provide that this annual fee is payable for each calendar year in each broker district where the broker was issued a permit to conduct business by the due date which is published in the Federal Register annually.

It is anticipated that for subsequent years, the annual user fee for customs brokers will be due on or about the twentieth of January of each year.
