
SUBJECT: Filming at the U.S. Customhouse on March 26, 2008

The filming crew of "Army Wives" has requested to film a scene for the show in the cortile area of the Customhouse on Wednesday, March 26, 2008. The filming schedule was developed to ensure minimal disruption to the trade community and the business conducted at the Customhouse.

The set up for the production will take place on Monday and Tuesday of that week. It is expected that the furnishings will be rearranged to transform the cortile area (in front of the Entry Section offices) into a bus station. There will be a number of electrical cords on the floor so please use caution when walking through this area. Please note that it will be "business as usual" on those two days.

On Wednesday, March 26th filming is set to begin at 4:00 p.m. near the East Bay doorway and in front of the Entry offices. If possible, we would like to ask our Trade community to conduct any business at the Customhouse that day prior to 4:00 p.m. In the event that a visit to the Customhouse is necessary between 4:00 and 4:30, they have asked that the door facing Concord Street be utilized to enter the building. All filming will be completed Wednesday evening.
