1. Purpose

The purpose of this Information Notice is to solicit written comments regarding applicants who have applied to operate a Centralized Examination Station (CES) in the Port of Charleston, South Carolina. Comments must be received in writing within 30 calendar days from the date of this Notice.

2. Background


