SUBJECT: Implementation of the New CBP Form 7501 (Entry Summary) Version

This is to provide notice that effective April 1, 2010, Custom and Border Protection (CBP) shall no longer accept CF Form or CBP Form 7501 versions dated prior to June 2009. The only authorized form is CBP Form 7501 dated June 2009.

CBP Form 7501's submitted to CBP with a date of entry on or after April 1, 2010 must use the June 2009 version of the form. Any other CF or CBP 7501 version used will be rejected back to the broker requiring that the new version be used.
